Grey Wolf Publications will provide cover art. If the author has cover art of their own they may send it to the publisher for use on the ebook. Grey Wolf Publication reserves the right to refuse to use any cover art that the author provides if deemed unsuitable for whatever reason.

The author guarantees that this ebook is free from:

- Infringement of copyright in any/all countries
- Racism
- Breach of privacy
- Misrepresentation of facts
- Is in no way libellous in any/all countries

The author is permitted to enter into other contracts with other publishers, provided the said contract is not exclusive. If the author wishes to enter into an exclusive contract with another publisher the author must give 60 days notice to end this contract otherwise the contract with the new publisher will not be valid.

The author agrees to give Grey Wolf Publications the non-exclusive rights to publish this ebook digitally, in electronic format, (in any digital format that the publisher deems necessary) over the internet. The author also agrees that any person who buys this ebook may download it and print off a copy to read, if they wish. It is obviously very easy for people to distribute and replicate information provided in this format. If a customer should distribute or replicate the ebook illegally, the author may not hold the publisher responsible. The ebook is not protected with DRM (digital rights management) software.

The author will provide a manuscript in Word or RTF format in order that the publisher may use it to edit and publish. The publisher is not liable for any lost or damaged manuscripts. The author must keep a back up copy of the manuscript at all times.

Royalties and Statements

The publisher and author will mutually agree a selling price for the ebook. Grey Wolf Publications agrees to pay the author 50% of all monies paid to them. For example, 50% of the income from ebooks sold on www.greywolfpublications.com but only 50% of any profits from the sale of ebooks on third party web sites such as www.lulu.com.

Grey Wolf Publications has the right to approach third parties in order to find other avenues to sell the ebook and to publish the work on third party web sites. These third parties may change from time-to-time but may include www.lulu.com, www.mobipocket.com and www.kindle.com. The publisher does not guarantee that the ebook will be published on these web sites.

If the publisher decides that the price set for the ebook is too high they have the right to lower it or place it on sale.

Royalties will be calculated and paid monthly electronically via Paypal provided the total amount is more than £10 sterling. The author is responsible for arranging to pay tax to their government.
